## Acanthus Carving

### Tool List (Sheffield):

#### Romanesque Acanthus

- 60° V tool x 3/8 and 1/4in. (10 and 6mm.)
- #4 x 3/8 and 1/4in. (10 and 6mm.)
- #5 x 5/8in. (16mm.)
- #6 x 5/16in. (8mm.)
- #9 x 1/8in. (3mm.)
- #10 x 3/8 and 1/4in. (10 and 6mm.)
- #11 x 1/4in. (6mm.)
- Eye punch

#### Baroque Acanthus

- #3 and 4 x 1/2. (14mm.)
- #5 x 5/8in. (16mm.)
- #6 x 1/2 and 5/16in. (14 and 16mm.)
- #8 x 3/8in. (10mm)



I've put a scale on the drawings. To use the tool list above, you'll need to enlarge them so the scale reads true (ie 1in. on scale is actually 1in. on the paper).

ROMANESQUE ACANTHUS

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
